Taking on various projects throughout the tri-county area, we strive to promote participation with neighbors and community partners in the creation of urban forests, gathering places, garden spots and various other forms of plantings. These neighborhood enhancements are not only visually appealing, but also help to mitigate the effects of climate change.

Our mission statement is to “engage citizens, government, businesses and universities to establish a zero atmospheric carbon balance for the Mahoning Valley.”



Plant Ahead Ohio accomplishes these goals by providing educational programs, supporting established environmental groups and sponsoring hands-on events.

Here are some of our recent accomplishments:

- Collaboration with community land banks on creation of green spaces by planting native vegetation and pollinator plants in open city lots.
- Sponsorship of ZOOM programs featuring educators and field experts who offer guidance about planting requirements, provide resources to enhance habitat knowledge, and make recommendations for small scale plantings in gardens and urban greenspaces. A variety of current environmental topics have also been presented to enhance public awareness of climate issues.
- PAO provides outreach to various school groups and businesses for direct tree and native plantings.
- Networks and establishes connections with neighborhood garden groups to promote best environmental practices.
